The Ninja Jump provides five activities for children to explore including: soccer, football, baseball, basketball, and frisbee throw. The necessary equipment for each activity is provided and will be accounted for during the return of the Ninja Jump. The school/organization using the Ninja Jump will be responsible for replacing any missing equipment or the Ninja Jump if damaged.

The Ninja Jump will be available for pickup and drop-off at our James O. Goodwin Health Center located at 5051 S. 129th E. Avenue, Tulsa, OK 74134. A truck is necessary for transporting the Ninja Jump as it weighs 300 pounds.

Your event space will need an outlet nearby in order to plug in the Ninja Jump; depending on location you may need an extension cord. The use of the Ninja Jump will be provided on a first come, first serve basis.
