

IAK Transportation Service for Medical Appointments

Please note if the student's parent/guardian is able to get a ride from their neighbor, extended family member, friend, or live close to a bus route we encourage them to use the sources of transportation available to them due to limited funds for IAK transportation services. If the family has absolutely no other form of transportation IAK transportation services may be utilized.

Who: Transportation service is for students attending your school.

What: A transportation service to assist with getting students without transportation to their medical appointments (primary care, dental, vision, mental health, counseling).

When: We need to know 24 hours in advance in order to coordinate with the company for transportation services. However, we are able to coordinate with the company if a last minute situation does arise.

Where: The transportation service will only take the student and their parent/guardian to and from medical appointments. For example, going to the grocery store or stopping at QuikTrip are not allowed.

The students within your school are the priority for the transportation service, therefore, the transportation service is not for parents or siblings outside of your school. The company will pick-up the student and parent/guardian from their home and/or school and take them to their appointment. The company will drop-off the student and parent/guardian back to their home and/or school after their appointment is complete. If the student is cleared to come back to school the company will drop the student off at school and return the parent to their home.

This service may only be used by a family twice during a month. If a family cancels or no-shows for the service twice they risk losing their opportunity to use the service. When the transportation service is arranged, but not utilized the Tulsa Health Department still has to pay for the service.
